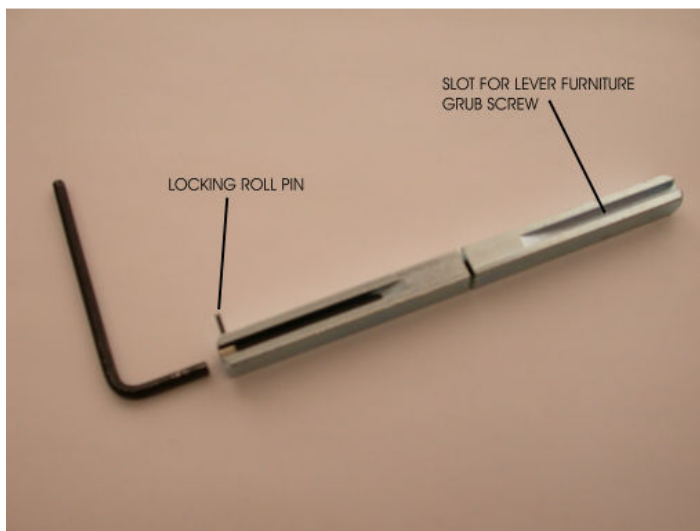


FZ1441,XX split spindle.

Split spindle for use with panic escape locks, with 8mm follower, on doors 32 – 70mm thick.



Fitting Instruction:

- 1 Undo the Allen screw through the middle of the spindle, and separate the two halves of the spindle.
- 2 Insert spindle into the lock case, the screw side should be on the "Secure" side of the door, the solid half of the spindle on the "out side" Making sure the slot in the side of the spindle will line up with the lever handle's grub screw when the furniture is fitted later.
- 3 Insert screw and do up using an Allen key (not supplied).
ONLY DO THE SCREW UP FINGER TIGHT, THEN UNSCREW BY HALF A TURN.
- 4 Check that the two halves of the spindle work independently. If operation of the spindle on one side of the door causes the spindle on the other face to operate, unscrew the Allen key a further half turn, aligning the flat faces of the screw head with the locking roll pin. Finally push the locking roll pin through the spindle to lock the screw head, and prevent further rotation of the Allen screw. (The roll pin must be squeezed into place using pliers, use of a hammer will possibly bend the spindle and prevent it from operating correctly)
- 5 Fit lever furniture and tighten lever handle grub screws onto the spindle.
- 6 Check correct operation of the lock after final assembly.
